

# Snow Removal Labour

## Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Landscape technicians are required to work independently or as a team member under the direct supervision of the crew lead. Landscape technicians are responsible for the maintenance of outdoor spaces by keeping the areas clean, healthy, and visually appealing. Responsibilities and tasks include but are not limited to the following:

- Promote job worksite safety, exhibit pride and quality workmanship.
- Performing all load in and load out procedures daily.
- Communicating with crew lead on any site deficiencies and/or upsell opportunities.
- Maintain accurate timesheet records for billing and payroll purposes.
- Attend training classes and safety meetings as requested by management.
- Operate and care for equipment and machines

## Winter

- De-icing and removal of snow from walks, driveways, and parking lots for various residential and commercial properties according to the specified contracts.
- Maintain a clean and safe job site, while ensuring current landscape and property is not damaged in the efforts of removing snow.

## Summer

- Taking care of plants, lawns, and other areas. May involve planting trees or flowers, laying sod, pruning bushes and hedges, mowing or fertilizing lawns, removing weeds and/or litter.

## Qualifications:

- Valid class 5 driver's license is required
- Previous experience an asset

**Physical Requirements:**

This position requires individuals to be physically fit and can endure working in various weather conditions.

- Capable of standing, walking, kneeling, and crouching for long periods of time.
- The ability to lift 50lbs on a regular basis.
- The ability to operate heavy equipment and machines such as lawn mowers and snow chuckers
